Please read this guide carefully before beginning the assembly process.

### Items to prepare












- Blank paper (with some thickness) • Glue (quick-drying type recommended)
- Scissors, precision knife • Ruler • Pencil • Tweezers • Toothpicks
- Something with a sharp point (used ball-point pen or stylus, etc.)

### How to construct

1. Before cutting the construction parts, write the part numbers on the back in pencil.
2. Place a ruler on fold lines and trace with the stylus (or tip of used ball-point pen, etc.).
3. Cut construction parts carefully along the cutting lines.
4. Read symbol descriptions carefully and assemble in sequential order.

(Where indicated, from number ①, then ② and so on.)

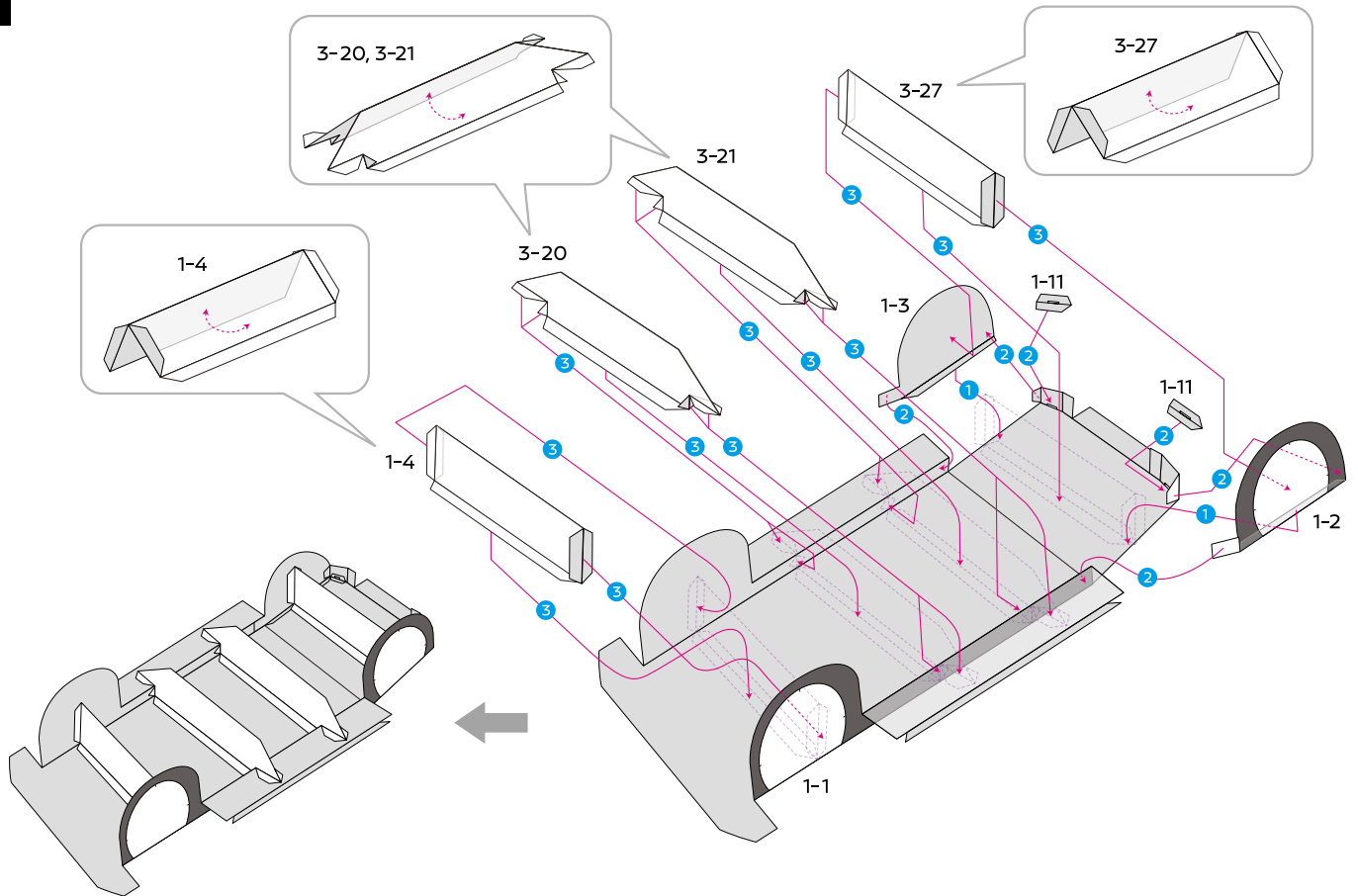
### Tips for ideal construction

- After cutting parts, coloring each cross-section or the edges using the same color as the parts will provide the best results.
- To facilitate easier assembling, properly fold and curl the paper before gluing.
- Spreading glue thin with a toothpick or other implement will result in faster drying and prevent glue from clumping or gumming up.

#### Caution

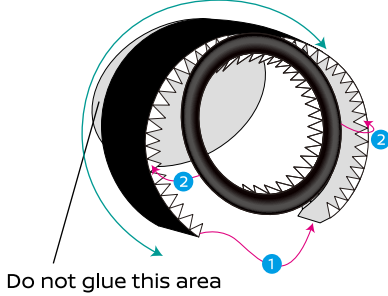
- Please do not use for purposes other than intended.
- Keep scissors, precision knife, glue and other sharp items away from children.
- When using scissors, precision knife and other sharp items, take care to prevent against cutting fingers.
- As very small parts are involved, take precautions not to ingest any, in order to prevent the risk of choking.
- Avoid getting the paper parts wet.
- Prevent fading or fire hazard by keeping paper parts away from sources of heat.
- When carrying take care to prevent folding or crushing.
- Take care not to cause injury from the paper's cross-section or edges.
- Take care not to fold or tear the individual parts of the paper parts.

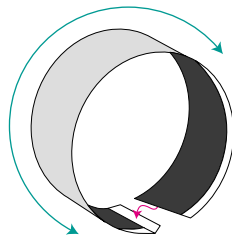

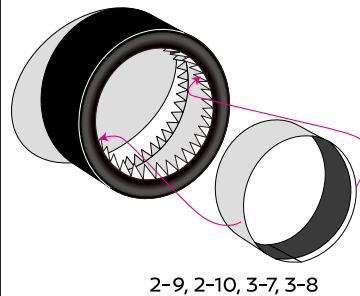


\*Curl the paper 2-9, 2-10, 3-7, 3-8

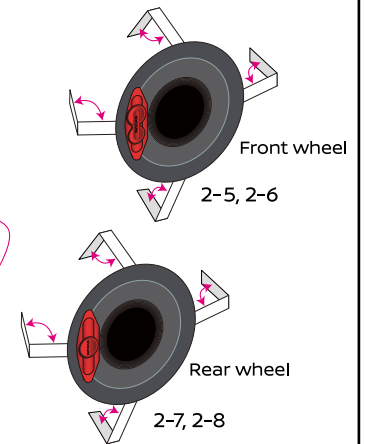

gluing position



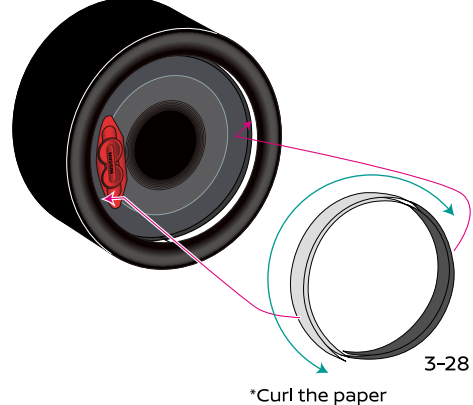
